RELEASE: Bullock to Blame for Montana's Fiscal Disaster

HELENA, MONT. — Chairman Debra Lamm released the following statement today on the fiscal disaster Governor Bullock has left the state in:

"I find it completely unacceptable that Governor Bullock refuses to take responsibility for the fiscal disaster he created. Bullock's liberal spending spree has finally caught up with him: He inherited a <u>surplus</u> of over \$500 million, ran it into the ground, and now we're left with a tax revenue <u>short-fall</u> of \$75 million. This is beyond fiscal mismanagement — this is complete incompetence. Bullock failed to show fiscal discipline and failed to prioritize our spending needs. It's absolutely clear that responsibility for this fiscal disaster lies squarely with Governor Bullock."

MTN News: 'State Budget Headed for Deficit Spending ... Tax Revenues Not Meeting Expectations'

The Bullock administration will announce Wednesday it's asking most state agencies for plans to cut 10 percent of their budget, to avoid deficit spending as state tax revenue flags and firefighting costs escalate, MTN News has learned.

Any spending cuts ordered by the governor apparently would be in addition to nearly \$70 million in cuts already imposed when state revenue failed to meet certain targets on June 30.

The law requiring the latter cuts also transferred \$30 million out of the state's firefighting fund to cover budget shortfalls elsewhere in state government.

 - Don't forget how the company that employs the wife of Bullock's budget director secured a <u>\$23 million</u> government leasing contract without a competitive

bidding process or looking at alternative sites.

(2) Next, Bullock beats his chest for working to "balance the budget every year."

- Governor It's a constitutional <u>requirement</u> and it's carried out by the Montana Legislature!
- Thank goodness we do have a balanced budget requirement because without it he'd never balance the budget!

(3) Bullock then makes outrageous claims about Montana's "\$300 million rainy day fund."

• There's no \$300 million rainy day fund in Montana. It's all but gone — reduced to maybe \$100 million — and with Montana's negative economic growth since the end of last year and declining tax revenues, it's entirely possible that we will run a deficit next year.

(4) Bullock also goes on to praise himself for "no new taxes."

- Well, Bullock VETOED tax relief bill after tax relief bill that would have returned money to Montana families

 he kept your hard-earned money so he could increase government spending and bring more government into our lives.
- One of the bills Bullock <u>VETOED</u> would have lowered tax rates for ALL Montanans by eliminating special interest tax credits for his fringe environmental cronies who coincidentally are now funding his campaign.

It has now been <u>revealed</u> that **Governor Bullock destroyed all his official state emails** while serving as Attorney General similar to how Hillary Clinton deleted her emails while serving as U.S. Secretary of State.

Actually, Bullock's actions are far worse than what Hillary Clinton did. She erased some of her emails. Bullock erased all of them.

"They no longer exist" — That's the official word from the Governor's office when a freedom of information request was filed asking for Bullock's email communications.

By deliberately engaging in the destruction of every last one of his public documents, **Bullock violated the Montana**Constitution and his oath of office:

The Montana Constitution clearly <u>states</u>, "No person shall be deprived of the right to examine documents or to observe the deliberations of all public bodies or agencies of state government and its subdivisions, except in cases in which the demand of individual privacy clearly exceeds the merits of public disclosure."

This raises some very important questions: What's Bullock's motivation behind deleting all his emails? What's he trying to hide or cover up?

In May, it was <u>reported</u> that Bullock and his staff "were using personal email accounts to conduct state business" a la the Hillary Clinton way.

Using a private email account, **Bullock was able to conceal official state business from the public** that would otherwise be subject to an information request if it had been communicated from his government email account.

Deleted emails Private email accounts ... Bullock and Hillary's actions run counter to the honesty and trust we expect from our elected officials.

The Juneau, Bullock Campaign Strategy: Lie to Win

Dishonest Denise is so desperate to win in November she has resorted to repeatedly telling outright lies about Ryan Zinke's public lands record. Don't expect Denise Juneau to apologize for her misleading claims at her public lands rally this morning. These false attacks from Dishonest Denise, Governor Bullock, and the Montana Democrat Party are all they have to offer because they believe they can only win by deceiving and lying to voters about their opponent's record.

<u>Independent Fact Checkers</u> looked into Denise Juneau's dishonest statements and concluded: "Juneau's claim is false. The bill that Zinke voted for does not authorize the sale of any federal lands."

<u>Bullock: Montanans WON'T</u> <u>Decide the Election</u>

Dark Money Chairman Governor Bullock has some serious explaining to do when he <u>says</u>: "Montanans, not big money, must decide elections," given all the **secret, big money he has**

Bullock Shows Lack of Leadership on Obama's Job-Killing Coal Lease Moratorium

Time and time again, Governor Bullock refuses to stand up and fight for Colstrip and Montana jobs ...

Last week, despite being invited to provide testimony, the **Bullock administration 'did not send anyone'** to speak in support of critical legislation that protects Montana coal jobs from President Obama's recent job-killing coal lease moratorium.

Yesterday, **Bullock had an <u>assistant</u> deliver a weak message** at another coal hearing on this issue and it was a slap in the face to folks in Colstrip and working men and women all across Montana. Instead, he released an "energy plan" 4 years too late that neither saves Colstrip nor protects Montana jobs.

If you recall, Bullock was also a <u>no-show</u> at a coal lease moratorium hearing in Billings last August— abandoning our coal workers in time of need.

Now, Bullock <u>claims</u> to oppose Obama's job-killing coal lease moratorium but when given opportunities to stand up to Obama he repeatedly cowers in defeat.

This is a pattern of Bullock paying lip service to Montana coal workers but failing to take concrete action to protect their jobs.

Look to a few months ago when Bullock permanently <u>killed</u> the Otter Creek coal jobs project, refusing to issue permits—**blocking the <u>creation</u> of 4,400 high-paying Montana jobs**.

And, the job-killing energy agenda that Obama, Hillary, and Bullock are relentless in pursuing in the name of climate

change threatens to **shut down Colstrip** and **eliminate 7,000 Montana jobs**.

Their radical environmental agenda will have <u>no impact</u> on global carbon emissions— a statement made by Obama's former EPA administrator— but will put thousands of Montanans out of work.
