

Montana Republican Party 2026 Platform Convention Summary

Purpose. On Saturday, June 13th the Montana Republican State Central Committee will adopt a state platform ahead of the 2026 election. *See Bylaws, Section B., II., B.*

Notice. Notice of the convention shall be sent to eligible delegates at least sixty (60) days prior to the convention. *See Bylaws, Section B., II., C.*

Convention Delegates. The Republican State Platform Convention will consist of the following:

- 1) Republican incumbents of national and statewide offices and state Senators, and Public Service Commissioners whose terms of office extend beyond the first Monday in January of the next year.
- 2) Republican candidates nominated at the most recent primary election for the national and statewide offices, including candidates for election to the Legislative Assembly and the Public Service Commission.
- 3) The members of the State Central Committee. *See Bylaws, Section B., II., D.*

Platform Committees. MTGOP Chairman Art Wittich shall appoint Platform Committees consisting of eligible persons (i.e. Delegates to Platform Convention) to be delegates to the Platform Convention to draft proposed planks of the State Platform. A copy of the most recent platform is posted online [HERE](#). Any proposed changes will be presented to the appropriate committees at the Convention meeting for discussion. When a committee recommends a change to a party platform, a time limit of 15 minutes per discussion with a 1-minute limit per speaker will be allowed. *See Bylaws, Section B., II., E. and F.*
